From 11:00 p.m. on Saturday, January 24, 2009 to 3:00 a.m. on Sunday, January 25, 2009 the Garden City Police Department conducted a DUI saturation patrol within the city limits of Garden City, KS.

The following arrests were made as a result of the saturation patrol:

- Adam Unruh (21-years-old, of 2015 Mohawk Drive, Garden City, KS) was arrested and lodged in the Finney County Jail on an allegation of DUI.
- Helen Pina (23-years-old, of 211 Spencer Street, Garden City, KS) was arrested and lodged in the Finney County Jail on an allegation of DWS.
