MEDIA RELEASE

Release #1:

On Wednesday, November 18, 2009 at approximately 12:01 a.m. members of the Garden City/Finney County Drug Task Force served a search warrant at 1208 St. John Street, Apartment C, Garden City, KS. Upon entry, officers located Jana Marie Hamill (45-years-old, of 1208 St. John Street, Apartment C), Sandra Ann McMillan (27-years-old, of 408 West Thompson Street, Garden City, KS) and Takela Nicole Houston (32-years-old, of 306 Buffalo Jones Avenue, Apartment 1, Garden City, KS) inside the apartment.

During a search of the residence, officers found three bags of suspected marijuana weighing 43.7 grams, 2 grams of suspected methamphetamine and items of drug paraphernalia related to the use and distribution of controlled substances. During a search of Jana Hamill, officers located 1 gram of suspected methamphetamine and approximately \$300.00 in her purse. During a search of Takela Houston, officers found 5.7 grams of suspected methamphetamine and \$812.00. Officers found two small bags of suspected marijuana where Sandra McMillan was located and found 15.9 grams of suspected methamphetamine on her person. Officers also located \$1,588.00 in her purse.

All three were arrested and lodged in the Finney County Jail on the following allegations:

Jana Hamill

Possession of methamphetamine with intent to sell within 1000' of a school zone
Possession of marijuana with intent to sell within 1000' of a school zone
No Kansas drug tax stamp
Felony possession of drug paraphernalia
Misdemeanor possession of drug paraphernalia

Takela Houston

Possession of methamphetamine with intent to sell within 1000' of a school zone
No Kansas drug tax stamp
Felony possession of drug paraphernalia

Sandra McMillan

Possession of methamphetamine with intent to sell within 1000' of a school zone
No Kansas drug tax stamp
Trafficking contraband into a correctional institution
