Release #1:

From 11:00 p.m. on Friday, January 22, 2010 to 3:00 a.m. on Saturday, January 23, 2010 the Garden City Police Department conducted a DUI saturation patrol within the city limits of Garden City, KS. During the course of the patrols, officers stopped fifteen (15) vehicles, issued four (4) citations and made five (5) arrests.

The following arrests were made:

- Rubith Lujan (19-years-old, of 2914 Fleming St. Apt. 4, Garden City, KS) was arrested and lodged for DUI and consumption of alcohol by a minor.
- Kelsey Stimatze (18-years-old, of 1803 Koster St., Garden City, KS) was arrested and lodged for consumption of alcohol by a minor.
- Eric Hernandez (15-years-old, of 950 Jennie Barker Rd. #45, Garden City, KS) was arrested and taken to the PATH for curfew no valid drivers license.
- Irvin Vasquez (19-years-old, of 4101 E. Hwy 50 Lot 147, Garden City, KS) was cited and released for no valid drivers license.
- Marco Gonzalez (19-years-old, of 2026 Commanche Dr., Garden City, KS) was arrested and lodged for DUI, consumption of alcohol by a minor and no proof of insurance.

The purpose of the patrol is to saturate pre-designated areas with police officers that continually monitor vehicular traffic for signs of impaired driving. The patrols also place an emphasis on speeding, safety belt and alcohol related violations. The cost of the saturation patrol was covered through the Impaired Driving Deterrence Program grant provided by the Kansas Department of Transportation.
